### ***FROM THE PRESIDENT:***

This fall and winter seem to be offering lots of opportunities to show and sell your artwork, and I just wanted to bring a few to your attention.

Because of the long break between our juried show last August at the Eastern Shore Art Center and the next scheduled members' show in June 2012 at the Mobile Arts Council, the Board has arranged for a special exhibition in January 2012 at the Mobile Public Library West Regional Branch. The title of the show is "Hot Art for a Cold January" - an exhibition of colorful artwork to warm up the winter season and welcome the New Year. Look for details elsewhere in this newsletter.

A number of additional local exhibits are coming up as well, including another opportunity to show your artwork in the Mobile Museum of Art special exhibit celebrating Mobile's maritime heritage in December. I hope the Museum will continue to provide a venue for regional shows of this nature.

The Alabama Miniature Art Society will hold its Spanish Moss juried exhibition in March at Cathedral Square Gallery and has just issued a call for artists. This is an international show, but also includes miniature art by some fine local artists.

And our members' judged show is coming up in June at the Mobile Arts Council. This will also be the venue for prospective members to audition their work. We will be accepting nominations for new members over the next few months. If you know of other exhibit opportunities coming up, please be sure to share with Lynda or me and we will try to get the word out. And if any of you want to help with the upcoming WGAS shows, please

contact Kathy Friedline, chairperson of the Exhibits Committee.

I hope you are able to squeeze some painting in along with the other holiday festivities, and will look for you at the opening reception on January 5th at the West Regional Branch Library.

- **TAKE DOWN:** The show will hang through the month of January, with take-down scheduled for Tuesday, January 31st, 11 AM - 1 PM.

Joyce, also one of our members.

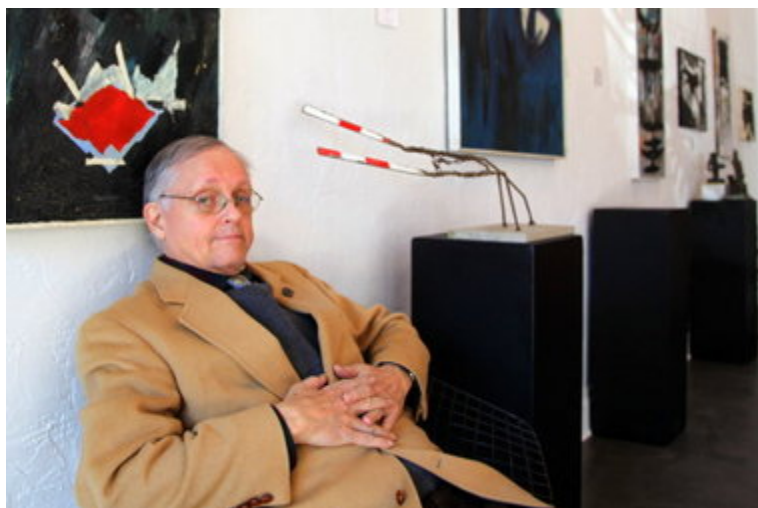
